PAST TENSES
"I went to last year."
"Who went to last year?"

"I had already seen when I went there with my friends."
"Who had already seen when they went there with their friends?"
"I had been living in/near until 2019."
"Who had been living in/near until last year?"
FUTURE TENSES
"I will be in next week."
"Who will be in next week?"
"I will be traveling to by next Tuesday."
"Who will be traveling to by the weekend?"
"I will already have been to by next weekend."
"Who will already have been to by next Sunday?"
"I will have been studying in/near for two months by the time you arrive."
"Who will have been studying in/near for a few weeks by the time I arrive?"
